

Appendix 3 – ARO's proposals following Stage 1 of public consultation

Background

To improve voting facilities for our electors and, as far as possible, to make polling stations accessible, the Council is carrying out a review of polling districts and places. The review is being carried out following guidance issued by the Electoral Commission.

The main issues considered in the development of the proposals for polling districts and polling places are that:

- No more than 2,500 electors should poll at any one polling station (not including postal voters); however, there can be more than one polling station in a polling place.
- The location, size, and layout of a polling station when deciding the number of electors to be allocated.
- Proposed future developments in the city that will increase the number of houses and the potential number of electors in a ward or polling district over the next four years.
- Accessibility to polling places for disabled people receives full consideration. We are consulting with and requesting feedback from electors, councillors, members of the public, disability groups, polling staff, and polling station inspectors and will take all feedback into account.
- Whether the proposed polling places avoid barriers for the voter including major roads, rivers, steep hills, etc.
- Feedback received following recent elections raised by members of the public, elected members or the police about particular polling places is considered appropriately.

The (Acting) Returning Officer presents below revised proposals for polling districts and polling places following on from the initial consultation period.

Alternative suggestions concerning polling districts and polling places are welcomed together with reasons for any alternative proposals so that they may be given full consideration.

(Acting) Returning Officer's comments and proposals

CD3 - Due to redevelopment of the Chesapeake Community Centre site the venue is no longer available. The use of Chaddesden Park Primary School has been suggested and considered, but due to lack of suitable space for polling, security and safeguarding issues this venue is not considered suitable.

Proposal 9 – CD3 It is proposed to re-draw the polling district boundaries to include the Phillip Whitehead Memorial Library in Chaddesden Park so that polling can take place at that location for the CD3 district. Minor changes to the boundaries of CD2, CD3 and CD4 polling districts will be required.

CD4 - A replacement for the polling place at the Nursery Unit at Cherry Tree Hill Primary School has been sought due to concerns raised by them about the impact of polling, however, no suitable alternative has been found.

Proposal 10 – CD4 That polling remains at Cheery Tree Hill Primary School (Nursery Unit). However, suggestions are welcome for suitable alternative venues for the CD4 polling district.

(Acting) Returning Officer's comments and proposals

LT1 – Whilst the use of Littleover Methodist Church has been considered as an alternative venue to Wren Park Primary School, the church lies outside the polling district and would not be suitable.

The use of Royal Derby Hospital for polling purposes has been also been considered, however, due to the issues around parking at that location that would not be a suitable alternative.

Existing and future planned development at the Manor/Kingsway site will increase the electorate at LT1 (Wren Park Primary School) above the recommended limit for a single polling station.

Proposal 15 - That the existing LT1 polling district be divided into two polling districts (LT1 and LT2) and that both districts poll at Wren Park Primary School. The revised LT1 would include the Manor/Kingsway development to the north of Uttoxeter New Road and the northbound A38 slip road. The revised LT2 would include the remainder of the existing polling district. Suggestions are welcomed for suitable alternative venues in the revised LT1 district.

Comments and representations received

1. *"The Polling Station based at Reigate School Mackworth is more than 200 yards from the street entrance. I am sure you want to encourage voters to arrive on foot to the polling station, but it is very difficult when faced with such a long walk from the street. I am 68 years old and quite fit, but by the time I have walked up Reigate Avenue, the extra 200 yards is very off-putting.
The hall attached to St Francis of Assisi on Prince Charles Avenue is much nearer to the road, has a larger car park and vehicles would not have to use a narrow street like Reigate Avenue. Furthermore this site would be closer to all the newly built estate on the former Mackworth College site. I really do think the Reigate site is no longer fit for purpose."*
2. *"I have no objection in using the Woodpecker provided that there is sufficient disabled access".*
3. *"I'd prefer not to use the Woodpecker because of accessibility"*

(Acting) Returning Officer's comments and proposals

MA1 – Alternatives have been considered to the Mackworth/Morley Sure Start Children's Centre due to concerns around parking and access arrangements.

The hall at St Francis of Assisi lies outside the polling district and would not be suitable.

A visit has also been made to the Woodpecker Public House, Woodford Road as this has been previously used whilst there was building work taking place at the Children's Centre. It has better parking facilities and is suitable for polling.

Proposal 17 - MA1 - It is proposed that the Woodpecker Public House is used for polling instead of Mackworth/Morley Sure Start Children's Centre.

Comments and representations received

1. *MV5 - "The facilities are fine but access is not. The driveway is narrow and does not allow both exit and entry to vehicles at the same time. This also has to be shared by pedestrians presenting safety concerns.*

The slope is also difficult for those with mobility issues and wheelchairs etc., coupled with the forced shared use of access as detailed above.

The better alternative for MV5 would be to use Our Lady of Lourdes Church. This location has better access off Uttoxeter Road. It has a community hall close to the car park and pedestrians pathways etc. It would offer far better and safer access.

Please can you take this as a formal request to change to the location of MV5 on grounds of ease of access, safety and better access for those with mobility issues?

2. *"There is the community centre in the centre of the village, car park at rear and good pedestrian / good mobility access front and/or back. It is Ideally placed with a crossing / nearby-by parking in the Parade / Square etc. It shares the site with the Library which also has a room suitable for a polling station with access available avoiding the main entrance if need be."*

(Acting) Returning Officer's comments and proposals

MV5 - Following a visit to Our Lady of Lourdes I consider the venue to be unsuitable for polling following a recent visit due to concerns about its availability and concerns raised by the venue. Alternative venues at Mickleover Community Centre and Mickleover Library have been considered..

Proposal 18 – That, subject to the facilities being suitable for polling at the venue, that Mickleover Library replaces All Saints Church as the polling venue for the MV5 district.

Proposal 19 - That the existing polling district boundaries for MV1, MV2 and MV3 be revised to accommodate potential development at the Hackwood Farm site. No new polling districts are required.
