Derby Enterprise Growth Fund (DEGF) Approvals

Purpose

- 1.1 Revised Terms of Reference for the Derby Enterprise Growth Fund (DEGF) Panel were approved by Cabinet on 12 September 2018 (Council Minutes ref 60/18). As a result of this revision, DEGF Panel recommendations with a value above £100k require formal ratification by the relevant delegated authority within the Council before the Agreement can be executed by the Council.
- 1.2 DEGF Panel have recommended the award of a £175,000 split into £80,000 Grant and £95,000 Loan to an applicant company; given the value of the proposed Grant and Loan, Cabinet Member approval is required.

Recommendation

2.1 To approve the DEGF Panel recommendation that the funding agreement of £175,000 is awarded to the applicant company, and that the Grant and Loan Agreement and any associated ancillary documentation relating to the project are executed by the Council.

Reasons

- 3.1 To comply with the DEGF Panel Terms of Reference and the Council's constitution.
- 3.2 To support projects as recommended by the Investment Panel.
