"Following the failure of the Conservative Government to honour its previous commitments to electrify the Midland Main Line, Derby City Council calls upon the current government to demonstrate its commitment to delivering vital improvements to our transport network by announcing when works to improve the A38 through Derby will be delivered.

"Improvement of the A38 trunk road remains the number 1 transport priority for Derby and action is urgently required to reduce delay to through traffic and to enhance local accessibility. The travelling public and local residents have previously been consulted about possible improvements but there have been no recent updates and the project seems to have stalled.

"We are anxious to ensure that the government remain fully committed to delivering the scheme and as quickly as possible. We request that they take away the current uncertainty by announcing the preferred improvements and a timetable for delivery of the scheme."
