lifestyle related feedback.

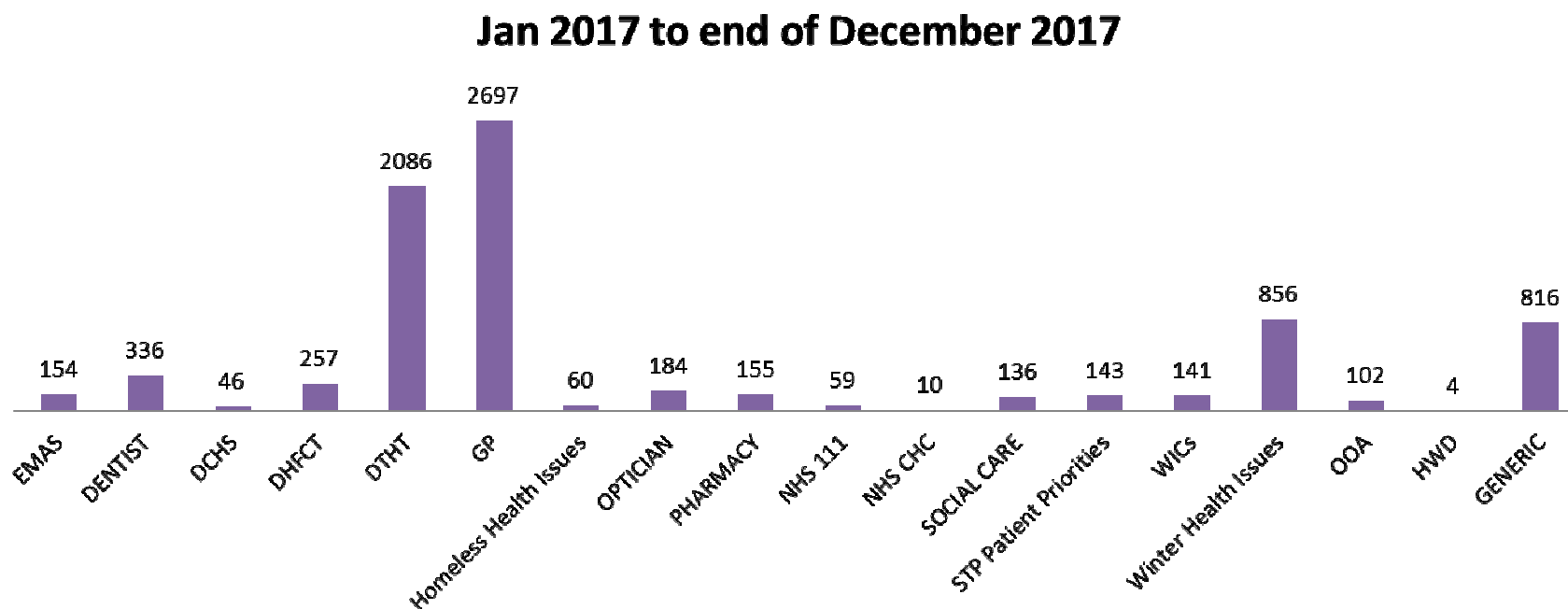


Volunteers, Enter & View

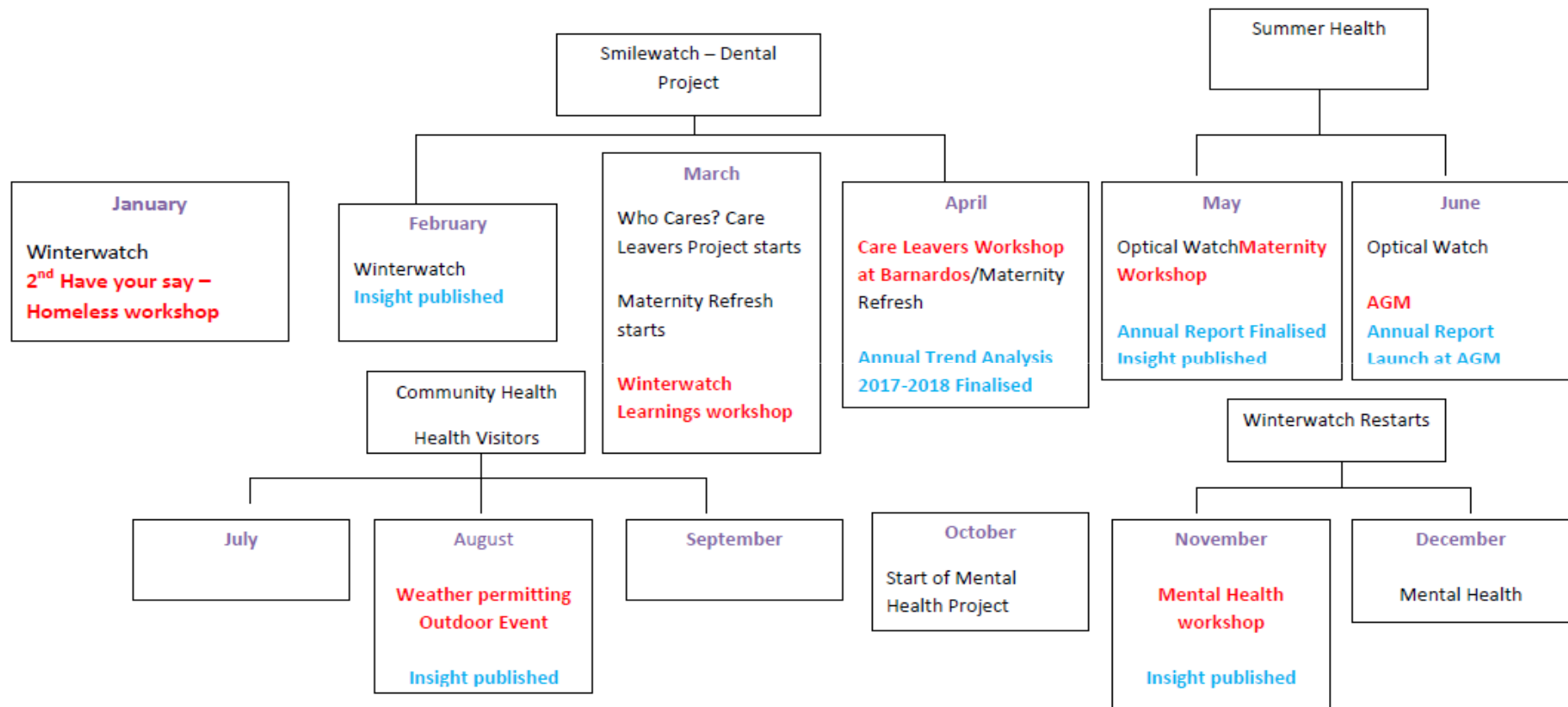

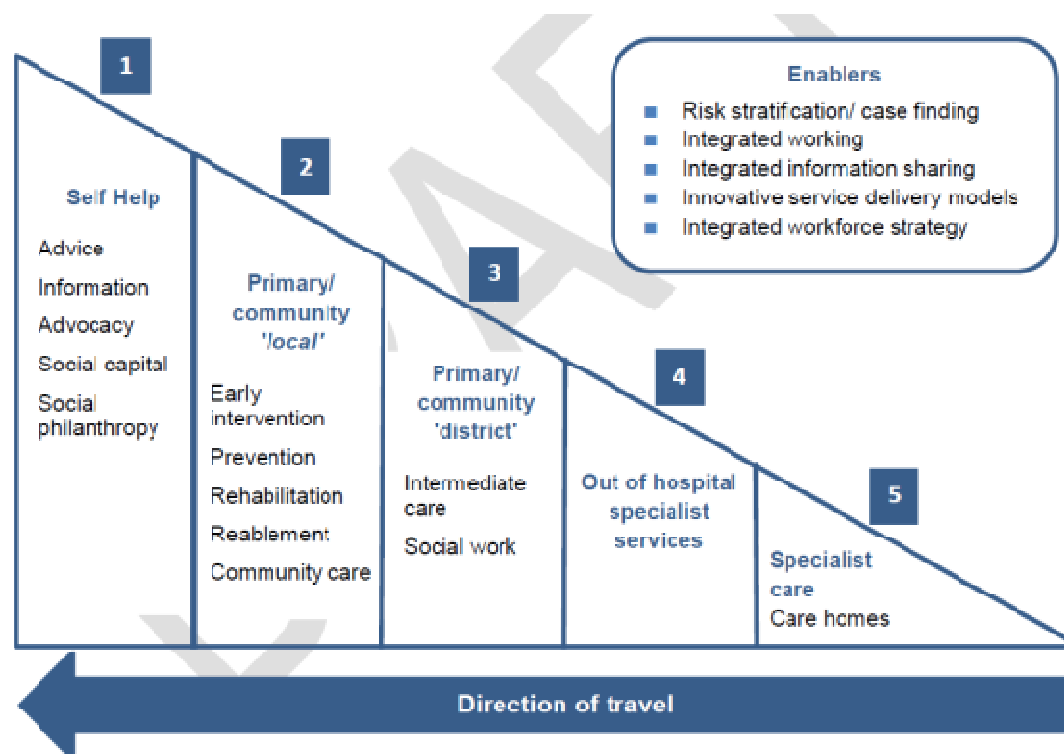
