## **Amendments to the Standing Advisory Council on Religious Education Constitution**

### **SUMMARY**

- 1.1 The Standing Advisory Committee on Religious Education is governed by its own constitution.

- 1.3 An amendment is required to bring the constitution up to date or provide clarity and robustness.
