Derbyshire County and Derby City Air Quality Strategy

Purpose

- 1.1 To provide the Health and Wellbeing Board a draft of the Derbyshire County and Derby City Air Quality Strategy.
- 1.2 To seek approval of the Health and Wellbeing Board Air Quality Strategy, and agree the development of a working group to develop and monitor the associated annual action plan.

Recommendation(s)

- 2.1 To approve the Air Quality Strategy.
- 2.2 To provide a Strategic Lead (Health and Wellbeing Board member) and Operational Lead (Air Quality Working Group member) for each respective organisation to drive forward actions identified within the Strategy and development of an associated action plan.
- 2.3 To agree a minimum of annual reporting to the Health and Wellbeing Board of progress against performance measures in the annual action plan and progress against population outcomes.

Reason(s)

- 3.1 To enable the Health and Wellbeing Board to work to reduce the health impact of poor air quality for the people of Derby.

Supporting information

- 4.1 The Health and Wellbeing Board agreed to develop a joint Derbyshire County and Derby City Health and Wellbeing Board Air Quality Strategy in January 2019.

- 4.2 The Strategy aims to set out the overarching principles and priorities of the Board to achieve reduction in the health impact of air pollution for the people of the city. The strategy utilises the Outcomes Based Accountability Approach.
- 4.3 The Strategy will be supported by an annual action plan, developed and monitored by the Air Quality Working Group. Partners of the Health and Wellbeing Board will be responsible for providing a Strategic and Operational lead within their respective organisations to be drive forward actions.
